IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by section 5 (3) of the Telecommunications Act, 2001 (No. 1 of 2001) the Minister, on recommendation from ECTEL, gives the following Notice:

**TELECOMMUNICATIONS (LICENCE CLASSIFICATION) (AMENDMENT)
NOTICE, 2002**

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Telecommunications (Licence Classification) (Amendment) Notice, 2002.

**Amendment of
section 3 of No.
14 of 2002**

3. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 3 of the Telecommunications (Licence Classification) Notice, 2002 hereinafter referred to as “the principal Notice” are deleted and the following substituted:

Services under the licence

4. (1) The following telecommunications services are classified under an individual licence:

- (a) Public Mobile Telecommunications;
- (b) Fixed Public Telecommunications;
- (c) Submarine Cable;
- (d) Public Radio Paging; and
- (e) Internet Networks/Services

(2) The following telecommunications services are classified under a class licence:

- (a) Internet Services Provision (5 ≤ 15 units);
- (b) Internet Services Provision (> 15 units);
- (c) Value Added Services;
- (d) Private Networks/Services;
- (e) Audio Text / Video Text;
- (f) International Simple Voice Resale;
- (g) Subscriber Television;
- (h) Television Broadcast;
- (i) Radio Broadcast;
- (j) Community Radio;
- (k) Short Term;
- (l) Land Mobile;
- (m) Maritime Mobile;
- (n) Aeronautical Mobile;
- (o) Amateur Radio;
- (p) Citizen Band Radio;
- (q) Ship Station;
- (r) Family Radio.”

Amendment of section 5 of principal Notice

3. Subsection (3) of section 5 of the principal Notice is repealed and replaced by the following:

“(3) The schedule provides the guidelines for when frequency authorization is required.”

Insertion of Schedule

4. The following Schedule is inserted immediately after section 6:
